Part 8 Public Notice Pursuant to the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (Article 81) as amended

Notice is hereby given that Leitrim County Council, proposes to carry out the following works in the townland of Drumod More, Dromod and the townland of Killinaker, Rooskey, County Leitrim:-

1. Construction of a 2m wide footpath for pedestrians with a 1m separation zone from the L1601 road carriageway. A bridge crossing at Killinaker Bridge where the path will reduce in width to 1.5m and the separation zone to 0.6m.
2. Provision of drainage, fencing, landscaping and other ancillary works.

Plans and Full Particulars of the proposed developments are available for inspection, or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, from **Friday 14th June 2024 to Friday 12th July 2024** inclusive, during public opening hours, at the offices of the Planning Authority, County Offices, Carrick-on-Shannon, Co. Leitrim.
