| Note | <p>As Chairman of the Premier Hall Action Committee (PHAC) in Thurles, I welcome and support the proposal to enhance O'Donovan Rossa Street. However, our group would have grave reservations about removing any parking from the area unless alternative parking is provided. Considering that parking is already at a premium on the street, we would consider it detrimental to the patrons of the Premier Hall to have any further parking removed, especially those who may have difficulty in walking. Perhaps additional parking can be provided at the corner of O'Donovan Rossa Street and Cuchulainn Road where the council currently has a lock-up as part of the enhancement programme; or across the road adjacent to the Civil Defence building (former Fire Station) where a small vacant area exists. There is also the possibility of negotiating the use of the parking spaces beside Thurles Courthouse, which were, for many years, available to the public outside of Court times, but which have recently been placed behind a barrier. Please note that the closest public car park to the Premier Hall is on Parnell Street, or off Liberty Square (Slievenamon Road or Ulster Bank car parks) - both are at least a seven minute walk away. There is some public car parking adjacent to the Premier, but it is very limited and frequently needs to be kept free to allow access to the rear of the premises. We wish the Liberty Square Public Realm project well and hope that our submission can be taken on board and in the very best of faith.
