Reporting of Political Donations by Third Parties

The provisions of the Local Elections (Disclosure of Donations and Expenditure) Act 1999 as amended in relation to third parties are designed to bring such person or persons within the political donation regime in operation at local government level.

A "third party" is defined in the legislation as any person, other than a political party registered in the Register of Political Parties under Part III of the Electoral Act 1992 or a candidate at an election, who accepts, in a particular year, a donation the value of which exceeds €100. The "third party" is required to register with Lettrim County Council, to open a political donations account and to submit to the Council a statement from a financial institution together with a certificate and statutory declaration no later than 31st March each year.

Individuals or organisations within the administrative area of Lettrim County Council who consider that the above provisions apply to them must register with the Council and submit all required documentation to the undersigned before 31st March 2024.

Roads Act 1993 / Temporary Closing of Roads

In accordance with the provisions of Section 75 of the above Act and Article 12 of the Roads Regulations 1994, and for the purpose of facilitating the resurfacing of Local Road L3413 at Summerhill, Carrick on Shannon on behalf of Úisce Éireann, notice is hereby given that Lettrim County Council proposes to make a decision to close the following public roads:

Local Road L3413 at Summerhill, Carrick on Shannon
 Date: Monday 25th March until Friday 5th April 2024 inclusive
 Alternatives: Diversions are along the R-280-1 left onto the L-3412-1 and left onto L-3412-2 to connect with the L-3413-0. Two-way system with entry into L-3413-1 off the L-3412-2.

All diversions will be sign posted and variable message signs boards will be in place. Access for emergency vehicles will be accommodated at all times. Access for businesses and local residents will be maintained but may be limited by agreement to certain times. Any person aggrieved by the proposed decision to close the road described may lodge an objection with the Director of Services for Economic Development, Planning and Infrastructure Services, Lettrim County Council, Park Lane House, Carrick-on-Shannon, Co. Leitrim, on or before 16:00 on Monday 26th February 2024

(a) Demolition of existing two storey building; (b) Construction of a two storey structure to provide for 4 no. 1 bed apartment units overall comprising of 2 no. 1 bed apartment units at the ground floor and 2 no. 1 bed apartment units at the first floor; and (c) Connections to existing public watermain, sewer and surface water drainage services and all ancillary and associated site development works. The proposed development is located within the Manorhamilton Architectural Conservation Area.




