Page 2 of the attached marked up drawing to be read in conjunction with the comments below;

- 1. Request for provision for 2no. Accessible Parking Spaces on Moyross Avenue at the location proposed in the attached marked up drawing.
  - The location marked would be adjacent to a potential entrance to a proposed new train station.
- 2. Request for provision for potential future entrance location off of Moyross Avenue to accommodate a proposed new railway station (at location shown in attached marked up drawing). Access required for pedestrians, cyclists and maintenance vehicles at this location.
- 3. Consideration to be given to pedestrians and cyclists crossing Moyross Avenue. A dedicated crossing to link the proposed University Avenue Scheme with the future proposed railway station access route should be considered.
- 4. Consideration to be given to pedestrian access from Sarsfields Gardens to future proposed railway station platform. We appreciate this has already been discussed but would like to note for record.

We would request that LCCC continue to liaise with larnrod Éireann through the development of this scheme and any adjacent schemes that may have an impact on the delivery of a future proposed railway station and associated -ENED. OAOA ROZA potential access routes.
