In accordance with the provisions of Section 75 of the above Act and Article 12 of the Roads Regulations 1994, and for the purpose of facilitating **The Cowboys & Heros Music Festival** in Drumcoura City, notice is hereby given that Leitrim County Council has made a decision to close the following car parks and associated public roads:

Dates: 12:00 (midday) on Friday 31st May until 21:00 Monday 3rd June 2024

Location: L-5501 Derrygoan (TD) from the Corgar junction with R-204-6 and the R-199-5

The access road from the R204 crossroads in front of Drumcoura City (Derrygoan) and continuing on to the junction of the R199 (Corgar)

Note: There will be exception for emergency vehicles, local access and the Park-and-Ride buses.

Alternative Options: From the R204 turn right onto L-1497 and left on to L-1502 to bring you out on R-199.

From Corgar, travel west along R-199 turn right onto L-1502 and turn right on to L-1497 to bring you on R-204.

Part 8 Public Notice Pursuant to the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (Article 81) as amended

Notice is hereby given that Leitrim County Council in partnership with Waterways Ireland proposes to carry out the following works at Aghoo, Ballinamore, County Leitrim:-

1. Installation of a pedestrian underpass on the R204 adjacent to Aghoo bridge. This underpass will tie into the existing canal trails either side of the R204.
2. Installation of safety barriers along the R204 at the approaches to Aghoo bridge.

The proposed development Leitrim County Council is a significant amendment to the previously approved Part 8 development, ref. P20/C/05 which included the construction of a pedestrian walkway within the arch of the existing bridge.

Plans and Full Particulars of the proposed developments are available for inspection, or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, from Friday 3rd May 2024 to Friday 31st May 2024 inclusive, during public opening hours, at the offices of the Planning Authority, Leitrim County Council, Aras an Chontae, Carrick-on-Shannon, Co. All submissions or observations should be clearly marked "Aghoo Road Underpass Project".

In accordance with the requirements of the European Union (Planning and Development) (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2018 (S.I. No.296 of 2018), Leitrim County Council has concluded that the proposed development does not require an Environmental Impact Assessment and will not be likely to have a significant effect on the environment. Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this Notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.
