

TOWN CENTRE FIRST - SUITE OF SUPPORTS 2024 PROJECT DEVELOPMENT MEASURE 2024

The Minister for Rural and Community Development, Heather Humphreys TD, recently announced details of the new Town Centre First Suite of Supports. The Measures announced will ensure resources are effectively allocated and provide support to local communities and town teams in leading the revitalisation of their towns and villages.

Limerick City and County Council is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) from town/village community groups and/or business interests who may have suitable projects for consideration under the Project Development Measure of Town

A maximum of 2 proposals can be selected for Limerick for progression to application stage. Grant funding up to a maximum value of €50,000 per application is available at a grant rate of 90% of total project cost and a minimum match funding rate of 10% of total project cost

The two Expressions of Interest that are chosen by Limerick City and County Council for onward progression to application stage will be selected based on how the proposed project aligns with the objectives of "Our Rural Future – Ireland's Rural Development Policy 2021-2025" and "Town Centre First – A Policy Approach for Irish Towns"

In the matter of a proposed S.179A Development by Limerick City & County Council, on lands located at Brugh na Deise, Bruff, Co. Limerick AND In the matter of a screening for an Environmental Impact Assessment AND In the matter of a screening for whether an Appropriate Assessment is required of the proposed development pursuant to Article 6(3) of Habitats Directive AND in the matter of Articles 81A (S) (a) and (6)(a) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended.

The proposed development, on circa 0.81ha of land, zoned for development purposes within the Limerick Development Plan 2022 – 2028, seeks

LIMERICK LEADER

(AS AMENDED) In accordance with Part XI of the (Planning and Development) Acts 2000 (as amended) and Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Limerick City and County Council proposes to carry out the following development at Moyross Avenue, Moyross.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

The proposed development will consist of the upgrade of c.200m of Moyross Avenue between the Sarsfield Gardens junction and the western boundary of the Corpus Christi Primary School, including:

- A realignment of Moyross Avenue through the Corpus Christi Parish Church and Corpus Christi Primary School lands;
- A reduction in the carriageway width to 6m together with raised speed table at the proposed new entrance to the Corpus Christí Primary school;
- The provision of parallel set down car-parking
- spaces on both sides of Moyross Avenue; Construction of 1.8m wide cycle tracks and 2m wide footpaths on both sides of Moyross Avenue:
- The provision of replacement car-parking spaces to the rear of the Corpus Christi Parish Church:
- Associated landscaping and siteworks.

The development is to be carried out in the townland of Ballynanty More, Limerick.

In accordance with Article 120(1)(b)(i) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended, the Local Authority has carried out a screening for environmental impact assessment of the proposal. Having regard to the information specified under Schedule 7A of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended, and based on an examination of the nature, size and location of the development, it is determined that there is no likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed

Nonetheless, a person may within 4 weeks from the date of the notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether this development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment. Such a submission should be addressed to the Secretary, An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1.

Limerick City and County Council in accordance with the requirements of Article 250(1) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) has carried out an Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening and has determined that a full Appropriate Assessment is not required in respect of the proposed development.
