Submission in respect to:
'Part 8 in respect of proposed improvement works to the Tipperary Hills Recreation and Amenity area.

No1 Bins. The existing bins are totally unsuitable, they are intended for dog poo but people stuff ~~them~~ them with other litter and consequently the poo cannot ~~be~~ be put in.

Replace existing bins with high quality bins like those on the main street which can take ordinary litter as well as dog poo and erect more than two. NB empty bins regularly.

No2. Erect a signpost on top of cup & saucer pointing the direction to say local villages and areas of historical interest eg 'site of ambush at Solohead beg. Post to be square at the bottom so that it cannot be turned.

No3 Replacement of seats Don't use seats constructed of steel

but instead of a strong composite material such as those at the tennis court in Kiffersle. Ensure they can not be easily damaged by vandals. Steel seats are nearly always too cold to sit on and remain wet for longer after rain.

No 4 Ensure all paths have a kerb to prevent tarmac breaking away

No 5 Erect 'no littering' 'pick up your dog poo' 'take your litter home' etc

No 6 Build an amenity area suitable for teenagers eg skate boarding ring like they have adjacent to the prom in tramore.

No 6 Encourage people to recycle ~~again~~ again like you see in Tramore ie a mesh bottle collector in the shape of a bottle and a can collector in the shape of a can.

No 7 Include the path / road that runs from the P & P car park to the Clanwilliam entrance in your tarmacadam plan

No 8 The ball adley which is a great amenity and is used by many people should be renovated have netting erected on the walls and have a spectator viewing ~~area~~ area and could be used for competitions

No 9. As the hills are used for walking & pitch & putt etc. A defibrillator should be erected at the pitch & at putt clubhouse and at the entrance from St Patricks Avenue. Training courses in their use could be held in the P & P clubhouse.
