Note	<p>As a lifelong resident of this area , three ongoing issues can now be addressed in full by this development 1) The extension of the Public Realm to the end of Friar Street is badly needed as the amount of dereliction on that street , compared to the pre millennium, is truly shocking . Is the development going to include forced regeneration , either through dereliction action/CPO of the former land commission building adjacent to the Supervalu development and adjacent buildings. That state agencies have presided over this dereliction and inflicted this on the residents for 30+ years can now be remedied. 2) The width and height of the footpath in Parnell Street coming from the existing car park to the junction with Castle Avenue needs to be raised and widened. It is a daily occurrence that cars and HGV's mount the footpath to pass through the street , presenting a constant danger to pedestrians. This is evident by the amount of subsidence on the footpath and a fatality is inevitable if this is not rectified. 3) The raised junction at the end of Castle Avenue needs to be of such a height to restrict traffic speeds in both directions up and down Parnell Street. The daily passage of HGV's through the "inner relief road" of Butler/Mathew/Castle avenues can be restricted by required roads safety measures and speed restriction measures. This is evidenced by the number of recent collisions outside the civic office buildings and further down Castle Avenue.</p>
