Leitrim County Council Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC) Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination

Proposed Greyway Development in the townlands of Drumod More, Dromod and Killinaker, Rooskey, Co. Leitrim.

Description of Proposed Development

The Capital Projects Section of Leitrim County Council are proposing the construction of a 'greyway' development comprising of (1.) the construction of a 2m wide footpath for pedestrians with a 1m separation zone from the L1601 road carriageway, with the bridge crossing at Killinaker Bridge where the path will reduce in width to 1.5m and the separation zone to 0.6m; and (2.) the provision of drainage, fencing, landscaping and other ancillary works in the townlands of Drumod More, Dromod and Killinaker, Rooskey, Co. Leitrim.

Stage 1 Appropriate Assessment Screening Determination

Leitrim County Council, as competent authority, in accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and Regulation 42 (1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011, as amended, has undertaken an Appropriate Assessment Screening on the proposed development as outlined above.

An Appropriate Assessment Screening Report has assessed, in view of the best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of European Sites, if the proposed works, individually, and in combination with other plans and projects, are likely to have a significant effect on any European site (known as a Natura 2000 site).

In accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and Regulation 42 (1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011, as amended, Leitrim County Council has made a determination that Appropriate Assessment is not required for the proposed development. It has been concluded on the basis of the report prepared by Liam Flynn, Acting Senior Executive Planner, informed by the submitted Appropriate Assessment Screening Report prepared by JKW Environmental Ltd. that the works individually, and in combination with other plans and projects, are not likely to have a significant effect on any European site.
