Arts Act Funding – Grants, Awards & Bursaries 2024

Annual Arts Grants Scheme

This award is intended to support organisations, groups or individuals in the provision of local arts activities which enhance long-term development and sustainability of the arts in County Meath.

Community Arts Grant

This award is intended to support community groups and schools in the provision of community arts projects which promote engagement and enhance long-term partnerships with professional artists.

Drama League of Ireland Bursary

This bursary is intended to fund a week-long residential stay at the Drama League of Ireland Summer School at the University of Limerick. The residency is open to directors, designers and actors working in theatre, living in County Meath.

Festival Grant Scheme

This award is intended to support arts festivals taking place in County Meath which show a commitment to quality artistic programming.

Professional Artist Development Fund

This award is intended to support Meath based professional arts practitioners in the development of their artistic practice and/or the development of new work.

Roads Act 1993 Road Regulations 1994

Proposed Temporary Closure of part of local road L-16184-0, Tullog, Co Meath

Notice is hereby given that Meath County Council intends to temporarily close L-16184-0 in Tullog, Co Meath between its junction with R122 and its junction with L-16183-0 and L-16184-0 for a distance of approximately 1.1 kms.

The proposed closure will be from 7am Monday 27 May 2024 until midnight Friday 21 June 2024.

This closure is required to facilitate remedial works on L-5085 Bridge on the Delvin River.

Alternative Routes

Traffic travelling South - turn right at Gibblockstown onto L-16183, turn left on to R108 at Harbourstown. Follow R108 to Naul Village, taking a left onto R122 Balbriggan. Road signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Traffic travelling North - continue on R122 Naul Road, turning right on to R108 at Naul Village, follow R108, taking a right at Harbourstown, onto L-16183. Road signage will inform traffic of diversion route and road closure.

Access for residents and property holders will be facilitated throughout the closure period.

Proposed Temporary Closure of R-161 (Navan - Trim Rd) Co Meath for Rás Tailteann Cycling Race

Meath County Council intends to temporarily close the Navan - Trim Road, R-161, at Connell's Cross, Balgill to Dunganny, Co Meath

The proposed closure will be from 2pm to 5pm on Sunday 26 May 2024.

This road closure is required to facilitate the final stage of Rás Tailteann Cycling Race.

Alternative Routes

Traffic from Navan will turn right at Balgill onto L-40081 for Shambo, then take a left onto L-4007 for Robinstown, through Robinstown Village on L-40071 and back onto R-161 at Dunganny.

Traffic from Trim will take a left at Dunganny onto L-40071, through Robinstown Village, then take a right at Shambo Cross onto L-40081 and back onto R-161 at Balgill.

Diversion and information signage will be in place.

Access for residents and property holders will be facilitated throughout the closure period.

Planning Notice PART 8 Planning and Development Act 2000- 2022 Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2023

In accordance with the above regulations, Meath County Council proposes to construct a new footpath from Kilberry Village to the Boyne Valley Lakelands Greenway, to include a new car parking facility at the crossing point of the Boyne Valley Lakelands Greenway and R-163 in the Townlands of Kilberry, Silloge, and Randalstown, Navan, Co Meath.

The Development will consist of:

- Provision of a 2m wide footpath, approximately 1.7km in length, connecting Kilberry Village to the Boyne Valley Lakelands Greenway
- Provision of car parking facilities where the Greenway crosses R-163
- Associated surface water drainage, boundary treatments, and provision for future utilities as required
- Proposed pedestrian structure to carry the 2m wide footpath over the Tatestown stream at Silloge
- Visibility improvement measures on R163 at Silloge

The Development has been subject to an Appropriate Assessment Screening in accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2022. In accordance with Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2023, Meath County Council has concluded from a screening determination under Article 120(1)(b)(i) that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and that an Environmental Impact Assessment is not required.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the proposed development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.
