Re: Part 8 – Proposed Birdhill Active Travel Scheme.

Dear Liam,

On behalf of Birdhill Soccer Club, I would like to make the following observations/requests on the above proposed scheme –

We are requesting that the footpaths and public lighting are extended on the northern side of the R445 towards Limerick to include the Soccer Field and possibly extend also to the Church. We have a lot of parents that drop their children to training and matches and like to go walking on the road while waiting for their children. This extension would allow them to do so in a safe manner.

In the village generally, we are requesting the following –

Extend the footpath from the Railway Station Entrance, over the railway bridge, as far as the Pollagh Trail. This is currently very dangerous for pedestrians.

Extend footpaths on Birdhill Roundabout to meet the hard shoulder on the R494 link road to the M7.

Extend the footpath on the Newport Road to the Community Park.
