On behalf of the Environment & Climate Action Section of Tipperary County Council, I wish to make an application to the Planning Section of Tipperary County Council (TCC) for Part 8 planning permission with regard to the development of land situated in the T^d of Fethard, Fethard Town (Killenaule Rd), Clonmel, Co. Tipperary as a new multi-denominational Burial Ground for the interment of human remains and inurnment of human cremated ashes. The proposed Burial Ground and associated development works will include, in summary, the following:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Main Gate & Disability Access Gate; • 33 space Car park to the front; • Provision of a total of 997 grave plots (2-burials per plot) constructed over 3 Phases; • Cemetery access roads & access paths; • Central Reflection Area with seating & planting; • 4 No Columbarium Walls; • Utility Shed & WC; • Waste Soil/Grass Collection Area 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removal of existing hedgerow (adjoining agricultural lands) and replacing with Timber Post & Tension Mesh Fencing & Farm entrance Gate in order to facilitate sightline requirements; • Provision of landscaping works & seating to burial ground and associated areas; • Provision of Services facilities: surface water, foul sewage and water supply; • Installation of Cemetery public lighting scheme on a phased and 'as the need arises' basis.
<p>The total area of land required for the development comprises 0.972 ha (2.403 ac).</p>
